Dear friend in Christ,

I'm Pastor Tim Sergie of the River of Life Assembly of God in Nome, Alaska. I am Yup'ik Eskimo from Bethel and Togiak in the Lower Kuskokwim and Bristol Bay regions. I am also proud to say that I host *The Breakfast Club* on KICY AM-850 weekday mornings from 7 to 9. I am a CareForce prayer partner and hear firsthand the importance of KICY to our listeners in all of the villages throughout western Alaska.



I have two requests for you. The first is very simple. I would appreciate if you would take a few minutes and pray for KICY each day. We know the importance of steadfast prayer and how it positively impacts our radio ministry. Specifically, we are asking for prayer for additional volunteer staff members. Arctic Alaska can be cold, dark and forbidding. But, as we say, "It's always sunny and 72 indoors". And, the work is profoundly satisfying.

The other request is to prayerfully consider a year-end gift to our radio ministry. Gasoline is nearly \$4.30 a gallon in Nome. But, it's true, we have few roads. Much more critical is the cost of home heating oil at \$3.64 a gallon and the cost of electricity to keep our transmitters going. Many families are faced with the question of "Do we heat...or eat?" We don't want to have to make similar decisions.

KICY is one of the most unique radio stations in North America. We have been given a huge blessing with a 50,000 watt signal. That has been doubly blessed with permission to turn all of that power into Russia every night from 11 pm to 4 am. Yes, God has given you a great blessing. Help keep us strong, vital and healthy. I know we are touching thousands of lives every single day with Christian music and Biblical teaching. We would value your partnership.
